Dear Parent /Guardian

Our Junior and Senior Choirs will be performing in the annual Children Sing Festival in week 7 of this term, at the Octagon Theatre UWA. This exciting choral festival offers our students an opportunity to perform in a magnificent venue and before an audience of 500 students and parents. The festival runs over 9 sessions and involves 47 primary school choirs. This festival is not a competition but gives students the chance to listen to other primary school choirs perform. Each choir performs 2 songs and participates in a community sing - along.

The children need to be immaculately dressed in their choir uniform.

School T-shirt (**NOT** faction colours), navy skirt, skorts or school shorts, white socks and sensible enclosed shoes eg sneakers. (NO tracksuit pants or coloured stockings or leggings). Girls must have their hair tied back off their face and jewellery to be kept to a minimum. School jumper or jacket only to be worn.

We will have morning tea before we leave. Students are to take a drink bottle (water only) and their lunch which needs to be in a disposable plastic bag, clearly labelled with their name. School bags can be left outside their classroom and will not be taken on the excursion. Please ensure all jumpers and drink containers are clearly labelled with student's name.

### Tickets for Children Sing Festival

As funding for these types of festivals has gradually been withdrawn by various government departments over the past few years, **this event has to be financially self-supporting**. The monies raised for this festival come from school registration fees and ticket sales. The festival costs over \$25,000 to run each year. (Students DO NOT require a ticket). We would love to see as many parents, grand parents and family friends as possible attend to support our school choir.
